Why do we need this initiative?

- Europe does not live within the limits of the planet
- EU policies on climate, biodiversity and pollution lack a sustainable resource perspective
- Europe/EU industry is **geopolitically vulnerable** and should become more strategically independent
- EU policy initiatives on materials and waste focus on the sustainable supply of resources, and not on ways to reduce **the demand side**
- There is insufficient focus on a just and inclusive transition



Timing

EU elections renewed Euro pean Parliament & Commission Consolidate & ensure the strong implementation of strategic priorities of the EU GD and the CEAP related to sustainable resources management

<u>For instance</u>: Ecodesign for Sustainable Products Regulation, Batteries Regulation, right to repair, CPR, Waste & Waste Packaging Regulation, green claims, etc.

- Which emphasis to set?
- Which tools should be developped in priority? E.g DPP, new methodologies, ...
- How to address the implementation deficit?
- How to ensure an effective market surveillance?



Develop a new resource narrative for the coming years: broaden and reposition the concept of Circular Economy

- 1. Anchor CE & resource management to reach the climate, biodiversity, and zero pollution targets and stay within planetary boundaries
- 2. Pay attention to the demand side/sufficiency: focus on societal needs, dematerialization, low-resource consumption
- 3. Tackle social justice: human wellbeing
