Extension of scope

• Current scope \rightarrow annex I, point 6.6:

Intensive rearing of poultry or pigs:

- (a) with more than 40 000 places for poultry;
- (b) with more than 2 000 places for production pigs (over 30 kg), or
- (c) with more than 750 places for sows.

• Impact in Flanders:

- 988 farms
- 60-70 % of poultry farms
- 20% of pig farms





Extension of scope

• Proposal \rightarrow Annex Ia:

- 1. Rearing of cattle, pigs or poultry in installations of 150 livestock units (LSU) or more.
- 2. Rearing of any mix of the following animals: cattle, pigs,poultry, in installations of 150 LSU or more.
 - threshold now at 150 LSU
 - Impact in Flanders \rightarrow 5057 farms





Extension of scope

• Impact at sector level:

Sector	Within scope IED
Dairy cattle	40% or 1070 farms
Beef cattle	12% or 343 farms
Pigs	90% or 1814 farms
Poultry	85% or 520 farms
Mixed livestock	83% or 725 farms

• Effect is disproportionate for farms





Administrative burden

- Farms under IED must comply with EU BAT:
 - implementation of emission-reducing measures
 - Providing plans, management systems and monitoring to identify and determine environmental impacts
- Extra costs for farmers
- Cumulative effect with other legislation
 - \rightarrow causes excessive administrative burden





Transparancy and participation

- <u>Proposal</u>: permits and inspection reports available on the internet
- Privacy of farmers?
- Stigmatising effect





Transparancy and participation

- <u>Proposal</u>: right to compensation for damage to human health
- Farmer must prove that he is not responsible = reversal of the burden of proof
- Very difficult to prove



Delegated acts

- <u>Proposal</u>: EC can add agro-industrial activities to annexes I and Ia
- In compliance with art. 290 (1) TFEU? Essential element of legislation
- Rules change without public participation
