- > adopted in Rio during UNCED in 1992,196 Parties (not US!)
- > 3 objectives reflect 3 pillars of Sustainable Development
 - conservation of biodiversity
 - sustainable use of its components
 - access to + fair & equitable sharing of benefits of genetic resources (ABS)
- > Covers all biodiversity on 3 levels: genes species ecosystems
- > 2 Protocols: Cartagena (on biosafety 2000), Nagoya (on ABS 2010)
- > Concurrent biannual governing body meetings of the 3 treaties:
 - CBD Conference of the Parties (COP)
 - Cartagena Protocol Meeting of the Parties serviced by the COP (CP COP/MOP)
 - Nagoya Protocol Meeting of the Parties serviced by the COP (NP COP/MOP)
- Several subsidiary meetings to prepare COP
 - 6 in current biennium: SBSTTA(25-26), SBI(4-5), OEWG DSI (1-2), OEWGArt8j

EU preparations and participation?

- Considered a 'scientific/technical' meeting so MS prerogative
- > Still need for consistent policy lines as preparation of COP16
- No EU position papers but EU Orientation Lines (EU OL)
- Not EU coordination but EU 'consultation'
- Individual MS and COM can intervene from behind their own flag
- Agree on choreography for optimal impact (who takes floor first)

Role more limited - still pivotal in preparation towards COP16


- Ensure cohesion of the EU

 - EU expert groups
- Ensure EU representation (courtesy)
 - Belgian negotiator on each Agenda Item
 - Presidency make interventions as BELGIUM, supported by MS/COM
 - engage in FoC, small discussions or ensure adequate expert participation from other MS/COM
- > Ensure functioning
 - logistics, rooms, support to MS, review documents

CONVENTION ON MIGRATORY SPECIES



Convention on the

Conservation of Migratory Species of Wild Animals



- 'Bonn Convention' adopted in 1980 entered into force in 1983
- 133 Parties including EU+MS
- Conservation of migratory species worldwide, throughout their range
 - Appendix I: endangered, requiring strict protection/restoration of both animals as places where they live
 - Appendix II: unfavourable conservation status, requiring international agreements and significantly benefit from international co-operation
- 3 yearly Conference of the Parties (COP)
- Often locally/nationally socio-economic important species.
- A framework Convention
 - 7 agreements, 19 MoU's, 4 Special Species Initiatives
 - 'The CMS Family' CMS + all Agreements/MoUs, etc.

38 Agenda Items - over 100 documents/decisions/resolutions

- Strategic and Institutional Matters (eg Strategic Plan, link GBF, synergies
- Scientific Assessments/reports (eg. review species conservation status)
- Interpretation and Implementation of the Convention (bulk of the work) (eg. National Reports, species-related conservation issues, deep-sea mining, poisoning, pollution, cross-cutting issues, connectivity, climate, livelihoods, bush meat, concerted actions, joint initiatives, etc.)
