

b) Ministerial declaration- state of play & next steps

- First draft received mid-August 2023 : general statements + actions proposed
- → BE <u>comments</u> sent to ES Presidency on 5 and 11 September

- Revised 1st draft expected by end September 2023
- → Discussion on the agenda of WPIEI on 19th Sept.

- 2nd informal consultation expected in October/November
- → Discussion on the agenda of WPIEI on 24th Oct.

Final Draft ministerial declaration to be issued in January 2024



c) EU priorities for outreach- state of play

Final concept notes (04/08/2023):

- 1. Enhance **circular economy** (CE) in support of sustainable consumption and production (SCP)
- 2. Promote action on the **water-ecosystems-food-energy** (WEFE) nexus in the context of climate change
- 3. Develop a global agenda for ocean protection
- 4. Formally acknowledge/adopt the outcome of ICCM5, promoting & setting the ground for further action at UNGA on the new framework on **chemicals & waste**, incl. any institutional follow-up relevant to UNEP
- 5. Addressing [deforestation and] **forest** conversion & where relevant and possible, reforestation







Additional areas of interest for the EU

- Solar Radiation Modification (SRM)
- Strengthen international **environmental governance** and UNEA's and UNEP's roles in implementing the environmental dimension the 2030 Agenda
- Promote relevant 2022-2023 global milestones
- Promoting synergies among the MEAs
- Raising awareness, mobilising the international community, and strengthening the implementation of existing **legal tools** (incl. promotion & implementation of the definition of **environmental crime**)
- Triple planetary crisis & global security
- Promote the engagement of all relevant stakeholders







d) Multilateral Environmental Agreements (MEA) day 28/02/2024

- UNEP proposed focus of 2 high-level dialogues:
 - "Analyzing existing gaps on means of implementation across MEAs and means of enhanced cooperation between UNEP and MEAs".
- → BE sent comments on 16/08 to ES Presidency suggesting a slightly revised focus
- MEA **Pavilion**:
 - ➤Inform participants about MEAs' work
 - >Showcase cooperation with UNEP/other UN entities and between MEAs
- UNEP expected to develop a background document with more info



Date	Deadlines
20 – 24 November 2023 The 10 th annual subcommittee meeting	 Member States in a position to do so may announce the intention to submit draft resolutions or decisions. Draft resolutions or decisions may also be submitted in full, if ready. A concept note (as referred to in the CPR-based review, subparagraph 13 (e) (ii)) should accompany the announcement or the submission of the draft resolution/decision. Such a concept note can be presented before a draft resolution or decision is submitted.
4 December 2023 (12 weeks in advance of UNEA-6 as indicated in the CPR-based review))	 Recommended final deadline for announcing the intention to submit draft resolution or decision (as referred to in subparagraph 13 (e) (i) of the CPR-based review) Draft resolutions or decisions may also be submitted in full, if ready. A concept note (as referred to in subparagraph 13 (e) (ii) of the CPR-based review) should accompany the announcement or the submission of draft resolution/decision.
