Today's Global Stocktake provides clear direction on how we can meet the expectations of the Paris Agreement by taking decisive action in this critical decade. To keep 1.5°C within reach we must act with "ambition and urgency" to reduce emissions by 43% by 2030.

That is why the COP28 Presidency has put forward an ambitious action agenda centered around fast-tracking a just and well managed energy transition that leaves no one behind, fixing climate finance, focusing on people lives and livelihoods, and underpinning everything with full inclusivity.







AREAS OF FOCUS



Mitigation

- Greatly expand renewable energy generation and low-carbon hydrogen production;
- transform food and agriculture systems;
- work with the energy industry to accelerate decarbonization and reduce methane emissions.



Adaptation

- Protect the most vulnerable communities and most critical systems from climate impacts, such as extreme weather and biodiversity loss;
- invest in nature-based solutions;
- expand adaptation finance for the Global South.



Finance

- Make climate finance more affordable and accessible;
- expand private capital directed toward climate solutions;
- answer the call from the international community for an inclusive reform of the multilateral development banks and international financial institutions.



Loss and Damage

- Help the most vulnerable to rebuild after climate-related disasters;
- operationalize the loss-and-damage fund.
